Purpose:

This event is designed:

1. To showcase the musical talent of 4-H members across the state
2. To show the importance of the arts in a healthy community
3. To promote teamwork and self-confidence

Objectives:

1. To provide an opportunity for individuals to work as a team and provide entertainment to the 4-H community
2. To provide educational instruction to 4-H'ers in music

Eligibility:

1. Any 4-H'er who is interested in being part of a singing group, who is 13 years of age and must not have passed their 18th birthday as of January 1 of the current year.
2. Each county may send up to 5 members to participate in the State 4-H Chorus Component of State Days.
3. A participant in the State Chorus needs to be registered as a full time participant, and not be involved in any other contest. The state chorus starts practicing on Tuesday of the event.

Special Requirements:

1. Each participant must fill out the State 4-H Chorus Information Form and mail to Phil Hoy no later than July 1.
2. Youth participating in the State 4-H Chorus, are unable to participate in any other contest or activity at State Achievement Days and must be a full time registrant.
3. Youth will need to have Black pants/skirts and white shirts for one performance, unless otherwise notified. Other performances require business casual dress.

Performances:

The State 4-H Chorus will perform at Tuesday Evening's Opening Ceremony, Wednesday evening, and Thursday's Award Ceremony.
